Support Developing Revision Habits

“Getting one percent better every day counts for a lot in the long-run”

Follow these four principles to build a habit:

- Make it obvious
- Make it attractive
- Make it easy
- Make it rewarding

Make it obvious

- Try to revise in one space
- Leave revision materials out ready to start
- Stick habits together e.g. home from school, homework, go for a walk, revise for 1 hour

Make it attractive

- Revise with friends/attend revision classes together
- Do something enjoyable as a reward once homework is completed
- Write a revision contract with your family e.g. time

Make it easy

- Start small e.g. 10 minutes and build up over time
- Reduce distractions when you are revising
- Ask family to get involved e.g. quizzing
- Create a revision timetable to stick on wall

Make it rewarding

- Track revision and never miss a session
- Reframe thinking e.g. “I want to get a grade 8 in Spanish” to “I’m a hard worker”
