#### **Corrections**

Our correction system has been updated which means that text messages are automatically generated for students if they break one of the learning habits such as Equipment; On Task Behaviour; Perfect Uniform or Punctuality.

This means that the system will send a text if the correction was logged on the system during the late afternoon of the previous day. Therefore a text may still be received even if a student is absent. This will also provide more information for families to inform conversations at home.

# **Year 11 Revision**

We are running revision sessions before school, after school and from Saturday 26 March a Saturday morning from 9.30am – 1pm. We begin our Saturday sessions with a focus on Maths this weekend and we look forward to seeing Year 11 students taking advantage of the in school sessions and the online masterclasses offered across the Trust.
