Dear families

I am writing to you about our revision offer for all students in Year 11 over the next two Saturdays. As we start the formal examinations next week, we will be offering a final bespoke opportunity for students to revise for their first English and Maths exams with sessions led by Mr Blade, Mr Clarke and Mr Kingstone.

Students should arrive at school prior to the start of the session and sign in using the paper registers at reception. Once students have signed in, they will be supervised by the teacher leading the revision session.

Students may wear non-school uniform when joining us for revision sessions in school on Saturdays. As you would expect, our usual rules and routines apply in school: we expect all students to demonstrate our core values of determination, integrity and respect. By maintaining a focused, purposeful working environment all students in attendance will be able to gain the maximum benefit from these sessions.

The below table outlines the programme for revision sessions this coming Saturday. Students should attend the Maths session relevant to their tier of entry and then they have the opportunity to attend a revision session on their preferred Literature text in the remaining session.

For example, if a student attends the first 'An Inspector Calls' session, they could then move to the unseen poetry session at 1100.
