	• Students can gain weekly certificates of achievement from their Head of Year, SLT link and the Principal.
	<ul> <li>Weekly attendance awards are given out to students who have consistently high levels of attendance.</li> </ul>
	• Students can gain recognition badges depending on how many steps they achieve on the MAP.
We would like more extra-curricular opportunities and enrichment activities	<ul> <li>100% of students have two trips per year – to climb a mountain and visit a university.</li> </ul>
	• We now have over 30 extra-curricular clubs available.
	• We have a greater range of extra-curricular clubs available, from basketball to badminton, from chess to debating.
We would like more information on how my child is doing at school	<ul> <li>Staff regularly make positive phone calls to highlight successes.</li> </ul>
	• Additional parent evenings offer more opportunities for families to learn how their child is progressing (i.e. Year 7 Meet and Greet; Year 11 Climbing the Summit evening).
	• Twice a year reports sent home to families to show attainment and progress following recent assessments.
