

Year 7 – Students FAQs

1. What if I get lost?

You will! Everyone does at first.

Teachers expect it and will help you find your classroom. Maps, signs, and older

students can also guide you. We do a lot of guided transitions to lessons so a lot of time your teacher will be walking you to your lesson.

2. What if I'm late to a lesson?

Teachers understand for the first few weeks. Just try your best and ask if you're unsure.

3. How much homework will I get?

More than primary school, but it's spaced out. We have a homework timetable, and we

will remind you every day in morning meeting what homework is due.

4. Will I make new friends?

Yes! Everyone is looking for new friends in Year 7. Clubs, form time, lessons, and

breaks are great chances to meet people.

5. What if I don't know anyone in my class?

That's okay, lots of students start without knowing anyone. You'll soon get to know

your Advisory.

6. What happens if I get something wrong?

Mistakes are normal. Teachers want to help you learn and settle in, they won't expect

you to be perfect.

7. What should I do if I'm worried or upset?

Talk to:

your advisory | any teacher | the pastoral team | friends or family
You're never on your own.

8. How will I remember my timetable?

You will be given a planner and a timetable to stick into your planner.

9. What if the older kids are scary?

Most older students are friendly and helpful. They've been Year 7s too and know how it feels!

10. What should I do if I get stuck in a lesson?

Just raise your hand, ask for help, or speak to your teacher afterward. They're there to support you.
